

## Memorandum with English Journals

RE2010 Organizing Committee, June 24, 2010

Organizing Committee of Renewable Energy 2010 International Conference, so-called “A”, exchanges Memorandum with designated Academic Societies\*\*, so-called “B” to be able to accommodate the paper in the journals of “B” too, considering the incentive of authors. The content of memorandum is described below;

- 1) “A” has the duty to complete proceedings with all full papers presented, and to distribute it to all conference attendees. Copyright of proceedings belongs to “A” in order to protect author’s right.
- 2) On the occasion that “B” wants to accommodate a paper compiled in “A” to their journals, “A” will transfer the copyright of that paper under the agreed memorandum with “B”. “B” can handle them in accordance with their rules.
- 3) “B” is recommended to write the appropriate wording, indicating the relation with “A” onto their journals.
- 4) “A” is to notify all authors of paper in advance that the path to “B” is opened, but submission is author’s option acted by author, and not for all adoption in “B”, and the rules of “B” is applied when paper is re-submitted. “A” confirms author’s intent of paper to submit to “B”, when full paper is received during the conference. “A” will transmit “B” on the information.
- 5) This memorandum is effective within the 18 months from the end of RE2010 International Conference.
